1. The language in the excerpt best conveys which of the following about the characters' feelings regarding each other?

Although nineteenth-century poet Emily Dickinson is well-known today, her poems remained largely unpublished in her own lifetime. Scholars agree that this was Dickinson's choice, but they disagree as to the reason for her decision. Some say she did not want the unique characteristics of her handwritten poems to be lost during the typesetting process. Others say she did not want the publicity that often accompanies publication. This second argument seems to me to be a likely explanation.
